## **Clean Vehicles Directive** Publication in the Official Journal of the EU

Dear Members of the EU Committee.

On 12 July 2019, the Directive (EU) 2019/1161 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 amending Directive 2009/33/EC on the promotion of clean and energy-efficient road transport vehicles, commonly known as the Clean Vehicles Directive, was published in the Official Journal of the European Union.

With this, the text (available here in all official EU languages) has become EU law. It will enter into force twenty days after its publication, i.e. on 2 August 2019.

The Member States now have 24 months to transpose the Directive into national law, after which the first minimum procurement targets for clean and zero-emission vehicles will start to apply on 2 August 2021.
